The 27th Annual Certification/Recertification Video Board Review for Physician Assistants

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This audio/video was recorded at the live Board Review course in October 2017 for video distribution June 2018 – July 2019.

This course is designed for all physician assistants preparing for the PA Board Certification/Recertification Examination. This course also serves as an excellent overview for nurse practitioners, and others interested in refreshing their knowledge in primary care medicine. Our goals are to provide the participants with a course that is focused on key content areas in Primary Care that include diagnosis and management of common disorders. The Review Conference is designed based upon the 2018 (Not the new 2019) list of topics potentially on the PANCE/PANRE as provided by the NCCPA, and by review of the [PANCE/PANRE board exam matrix of question distribution](#). Obviously, the exact content of the PANCE and PANRE exams is confidential and not known to the developers of the Review Conference, and no suggestion is made that the Review Conference or practice exam questions represent the level of complexity or distribution of topics on the actual examinations.

This Review course consists of Computer MP4 video, power point slides as PDF handouts, Text based pearls, and MP3 audio files. The estimated time to complete this course is 38 hours of viewing.

Learning Objectives:

After participating in this CME activity, participants should be able to:

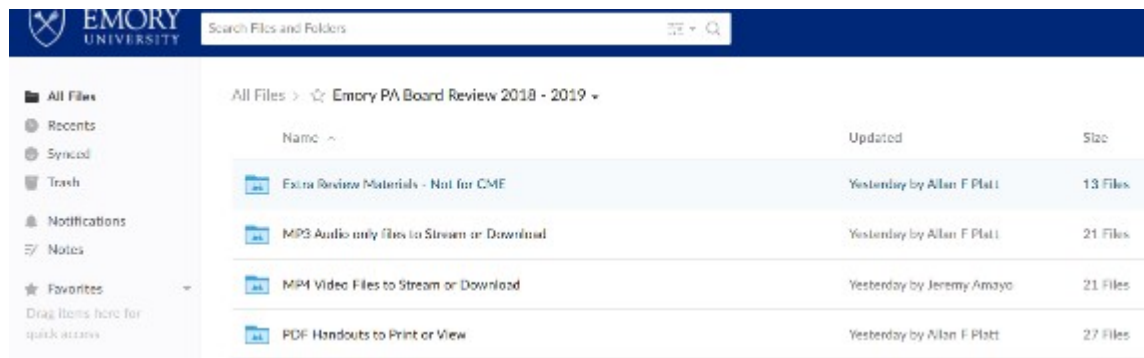
- Plan an organized approach to prepare for the PANCE or PANRE
- Identify techniques based on learning theory that will enhance exam performance
- Utilize testing theory to avoid unnecessary errors
- Identify clues in test questions to help choose the correct answer option
- Identify evidenced-based clinical knowledge resources to utilize for studying
- Apply knowledge of risk factors, prevention and clinical manifestations to arrive at a diagnosis/prognosis to create an initial management plan for several clinical conditions.

Viewing Requirements:

You must set up a free Box account with the same email you used to register for the course at <https://app.box.com/signup/personal/>. Get the free Box app for your PC, Mac iThings or Android devices at the app store. It may take 24 hours to set up your Board Review account and send you the email invite. Please

accept the invitation to the Box Board Review Folder from us **within two weeks or ask us to resend the invitation**. You can also use any internet connected PC to go to www.Box.com and login to see your folders.

You will have 1 year of access to 4 online folders to stream the audio/video or download the files to store on your devices to watch off line on your devices:

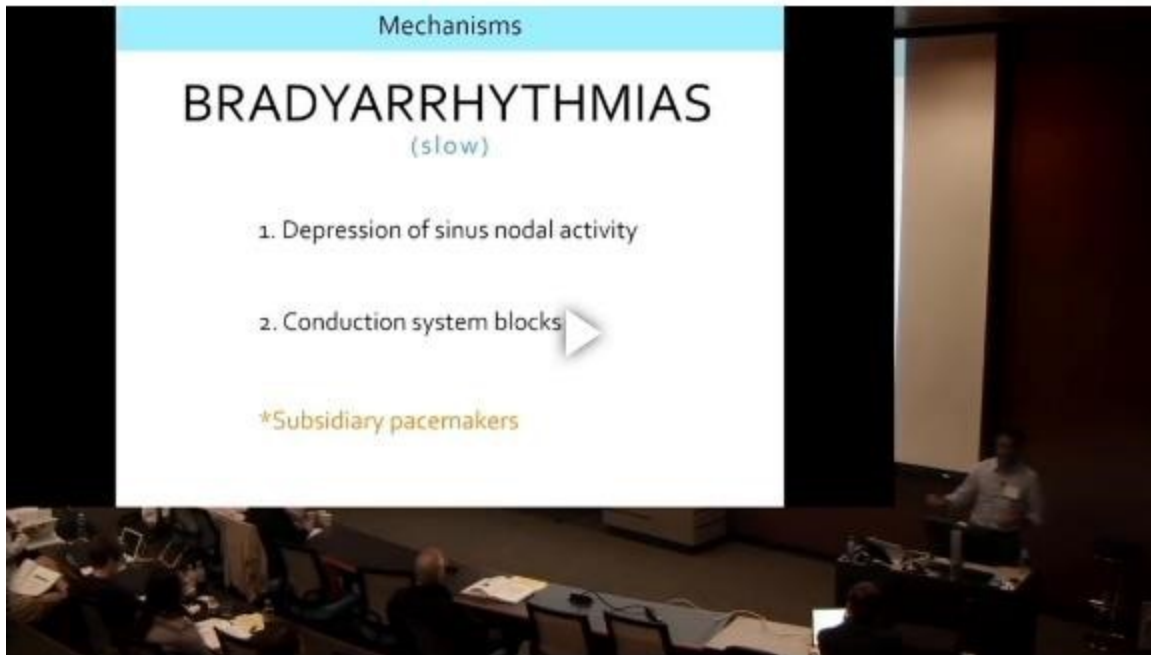


You can watch the video streaming or download it to your device by getting the free Box app from the Microsoft store, Apple app store or Google play (Search “Box” for the free app and install it). The video files are large so make sure you have enough storage on your device to download (70 – 220 MB per video). Streaming the video using Wi-Fi does not use up your storage, but it depends on having internet download speeds of at least 10MB/sec. You may use your internet browser to go to www.Box.com and login to use the files.

The MP3 audio is for use on an MP3 player like an iPod or you can download these files to your laptop or USB drive and burn audio CDs for your car.... The PDF files are copies of the slides ready to print if you want hard copy and is the printed syllabus we give out at the live meeting. There are “pearls” for review. The MP4 Videos show the speaker split-screen with the slides for best viewing on your laptop or tablet (iPad, kindle, surface....). You can use the free Google Chrome internet browser to open Box and play the videos with streaming to a big screen TV using a Google Chromecast plug in device.

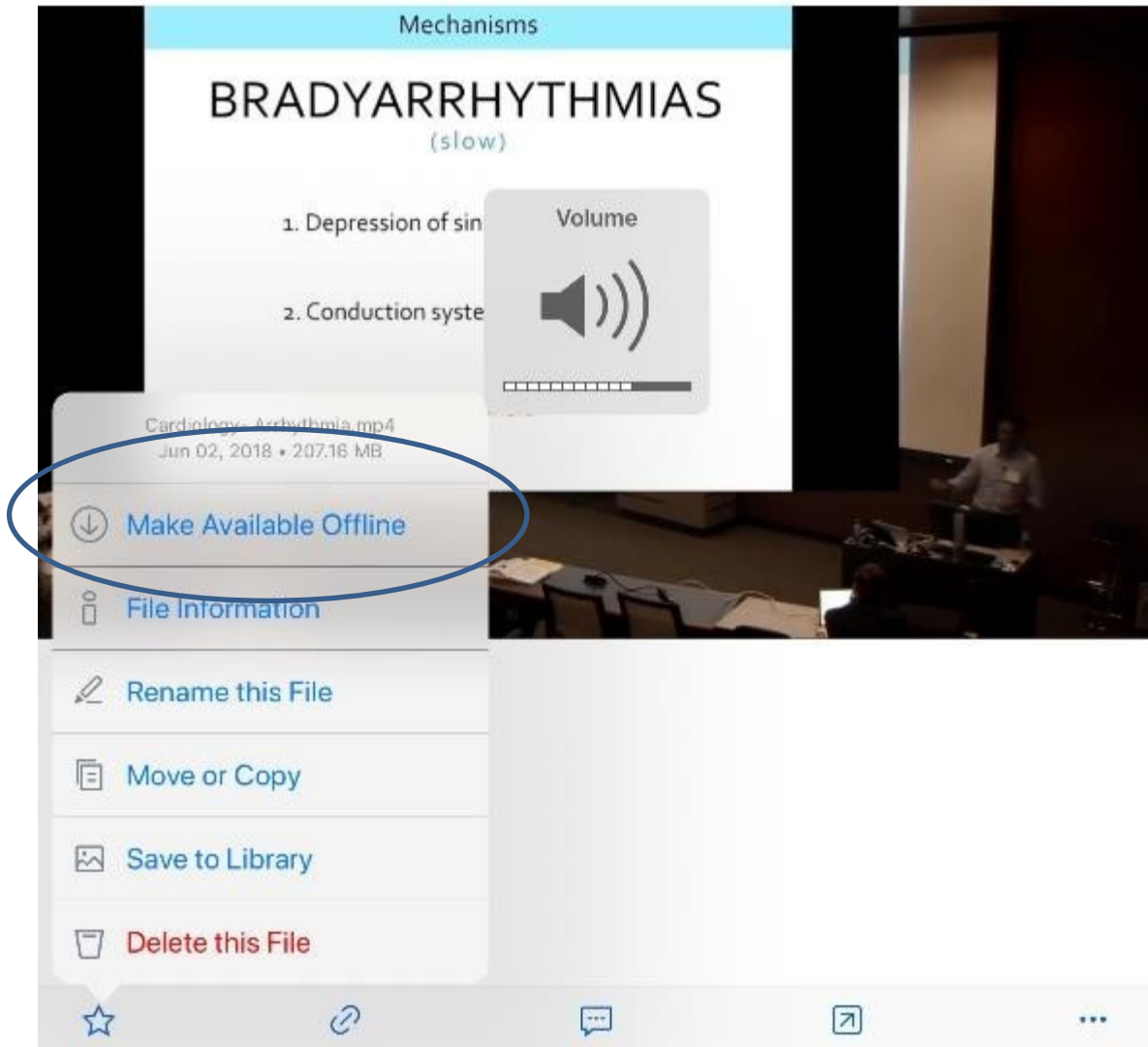
iPad/iPhone video downloads:

Open the Box app on your device – go to the video you want to download to watch off line.

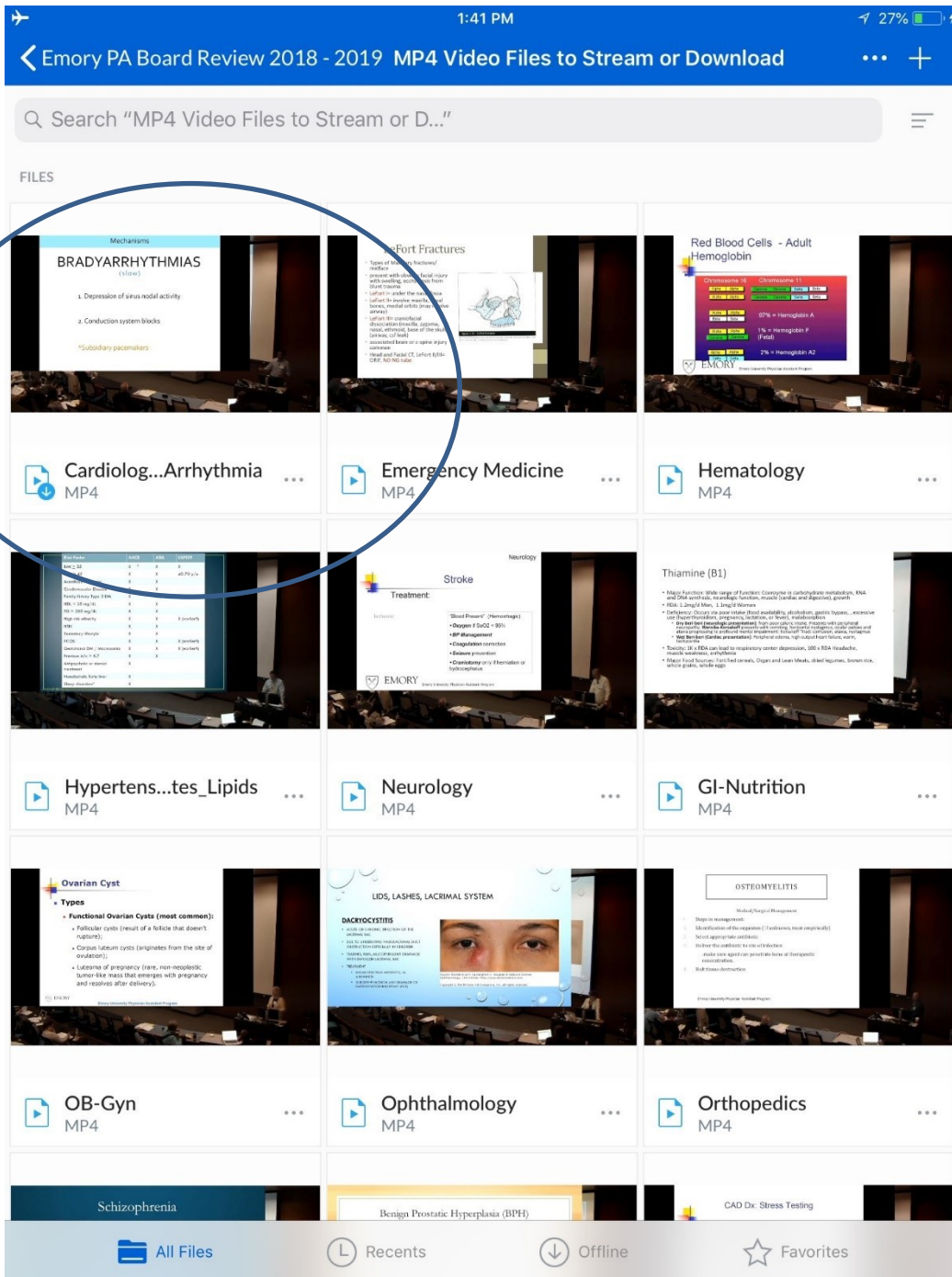


Click on the ... icon to open the menu

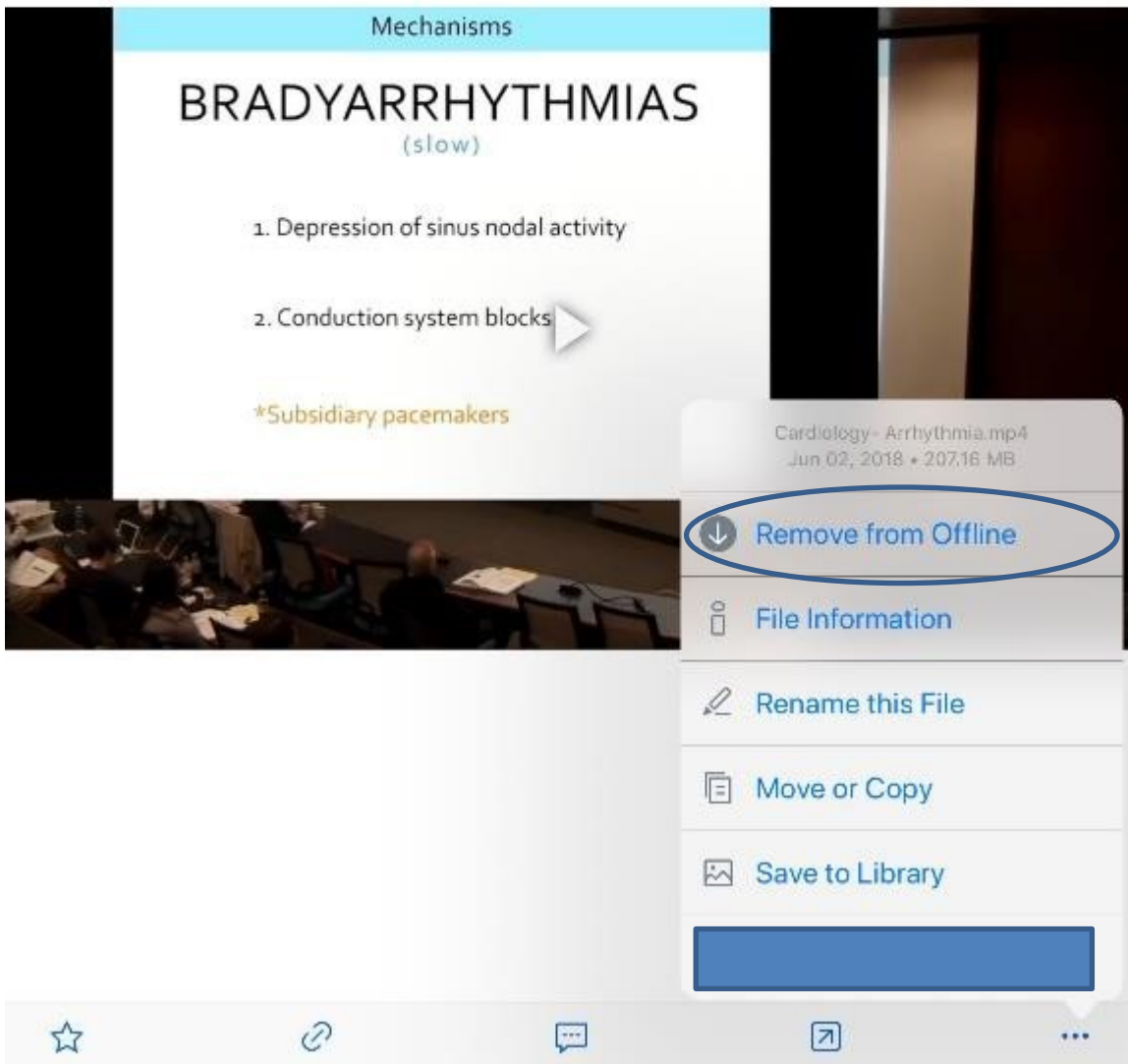




Choose the "Make Available Offline" option and the video will download to your iPad Box storage that you can view with Box offline.



If you downloaded the videos on your iPad using the iPad Box app, it stores them on your iPad to view in the Box app. Notice the down arrow shows downloaded.



The videos should play off line until you are done, then delete them Using the Remove from offline and download more.
